Saturday saw the men play a stableford in conjunction with a 4-ball BAM. Ted Edmonds won the day with 38 points in a countback with Geoffrey Cross. Ted also managed to record an eagle on the 15th. Jack Hepi came home 3rd with 37 and he was followed by Rod Jones and Joe Holahan with 36. Harry Edmonds, Steve Kent and Rusty Brien each finished with 35 points.

Jack Hepi and Steve Kent combined to win **the BAM** with 63 points, well clear of the next pair, Simon Smith and Dick Hudson who finished with 58. Next were Harry Edmonds and Jayden Williamson and Adrian King and Rusty Brien with 55.
